4 Metropolitan Parks and Recreation Advisory Board may form such

6 recommendations to the Board in order to carry out the assigned responsibilities  
7 of the Board; and

8 WHEREAS, an insufficient number of areas exist in City Council District 8  
9 wherein dog owners may exercise their dogs; and

10 WHEREAS, a study is necessary to determine the most appropriate site for a  
11 new dog exercise ground in City Council District 8.

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
13 ALBUQUERQUE:

14 Section 1. That the Mayor instruct the Metropolitan Parks and Recreation  
15 Advisory Board to appoint a subcommittee to determine locations suitable for  
16 dog exercise grounds in City Council District 8.

17 Section 2. That the aforementioned subcommittee conduct at least one  
18 public meeting in District 8 to obtain public comment regarding locations and  
19 operations of a dog exercise ground.

20 Section 3. That the aforementioned subcommittee submit a report through  
21 the Metropolitan Parks and Recreation Advisory Board to the Council and Mayor  
22 within four months of its creation that recommends a site for the dog exercise  
23 ground.

24 Section 4. That the aforementioned subcommittee consider criteria including  
25 but not limited to environmental impact, safety, neighborhood acceptability,  
26 sufficient size and cost in its recommendation report.

27 Section 5. That the Mayor designate a site located within the boundaries of  
28 City Council District 8 as a park to be used as an exercise ground for dogs  
29 based on the aforementioned subcommittee report.

30 Section 6. That the subcommittee submit an evaluation report through the  
31 Metropolitan Parks and Recreation Advisory Board to the Council and Mayor

This has the Parks Board establish a subcommittee of People from District 1 to study the location of a dog park in your district. The Administration may not be aware that the Parks Board can establish a subcommittee of people that are not on the Parks board. These people can issue a report to the board who can give it to the Mayor who can give it to the Council.

The Purpose of the Parks Board is as such.

**10-1-2-2 PURPOSE.**

The Board is hereby established for the following purposes:

(A) To keep itself informed of city parks and recreation needs and to serve as a forum for public discussion.

(B) To encourage the greatest use of parks and recreation programs including cooperation with other agencies and organizations which are involved in providing recreation services for the public good.

**10-1-2-4 POWERS AND DUTIES.**

(A) The Board shall recommend to the Mayor policies for overall development of the park system to include plans for additional parks and recreation facilities involving the joint-use concept with the Albuquerque Public School System and ways and means of financing improvements.

(B) The Board shall meet at least quarterly, and may hold additional meetings at its discretion.

(C) The Board shall conduct open public meetings and give reasonable notice of such meetings.

(D) The Board may form such subcommittees as are necessary from the public at large to make recommendations to the Board in order to carry out the assigned responsibilities of the Board. A member of the Board shall serve as Chairperson of any subcommittees formed under the provisions of this division (D).

(E) The Board shall prepare and submit an annual report of its activities to the Mayor and the Council.
